## E 43RD SHARED STREET Safety Improvements

Shorten Pedestrian Crossings

Enhance Safety

NYC DOT will implement a Shared Street on E 43rd St. between Lexington and 3rd Aves where pedestrians and cyclists share space with slow-moving vehicles:

- Add curb extensions on E 43rd and 3rd Ave.
- Refresh curb extension on Lexington Ave.
- Traffic calming measures with advisory 5MPH speed limit signage
- Add public amenities such as movable furniture
- Shorten pedestrian crossings on Lexington Ave. and 3rd Ave.
- Relocate Diplomat parking to 44th St.
