Restriction to Curbside Parking On Lexington Ave. between E.24th St. and E.26th St. (East & West Sides)

Beginning Monday, August 27, 2018 Until Further Notice

Please be advised, beginning on/about Monday, August 27, 2018 (weather and field conditions permitting), access to curbside parking will be restricted on Lexington Avenue from E. 24th Street to E. 26th Street (East & West Sides). These parking restrictions are necessary in order to facilitate utility work. The permitted work hours are 7:00am to 6:00pm. **Please observe/adhere to all posted signs by the contractor.**

- Parking restrictions will be in effect, **"NO PARKING" signs will be posted in affected areas.**
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency lane will be open at all times.
