Temporary Bus Stop Closure Southbound – M101, M102, M103 On Lexington Ave. between E. 25th St to E. 26th St. Beginning Monday, August 27, 2018 Until Further Notice

Please be advised, beginning on/about Monday, August 27, 2018 the Southbound M101, M102, M103 bus stop located on Lexington Ave between E.25th Street and East 26th Street, will be temporarily closed due to construction work. You may board the nearest available bus stops, located on either E.24th Street between Lexington Avenue and 3rd Avenue or E. 28th Street and Lexington Avenue.

TRAFFIC/COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

- South Bound Traffic lanes: Some intermittent lane closures, or slow moving, during work operations
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Emergency lane will be open at all times.
- Flaggers will be assigned to aid with the movement of construction equipment, pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
