Early CPR and the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) has been shown to dramatically increase the chance of survival in victims who experience sudden cardiac arrest. The first few minutes after a person goes into cardiac arrest are the most critical. Bystanders who encounter a person in cardiac arrest are the ones who can maintain blood flow to the vital organs by performing chest compressions, improving a person's chances of survival.

Come learn the basic skills needed to take action in the event of a cardiac arrest emergency. *Not a certification class.*
