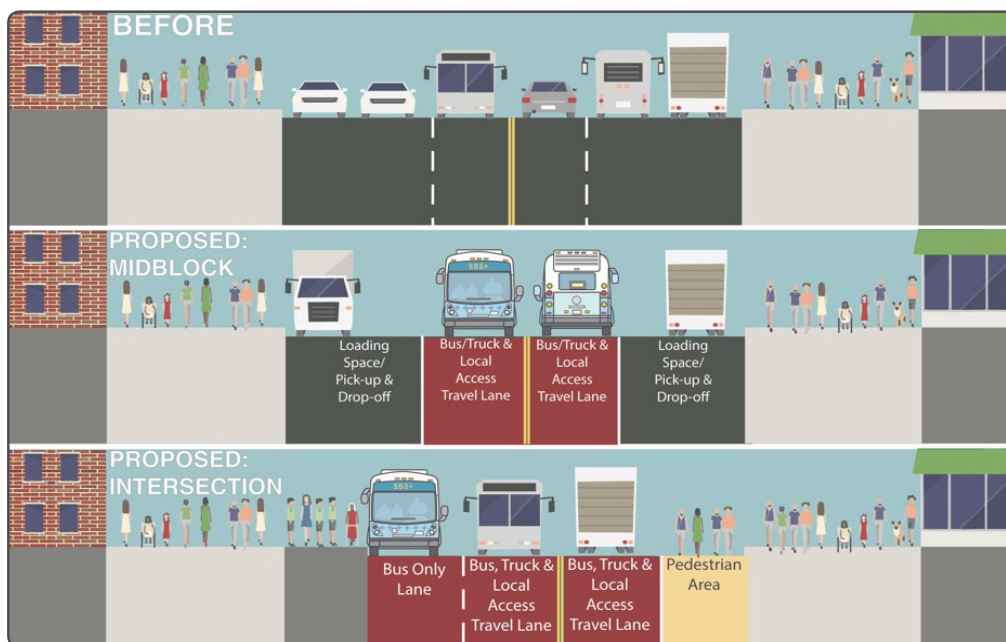

NYC DOT will implement a pilot project including bus and road safety improvements on 14th Street from 1st Avenue to 9th Avenue:

- Install bus and truck priority lane markings and signage
- Restrict daytime/evening through movements for all vehicles except buses and trucks
- Expand pedestrian space at Union Square
- Shorten pedestrian crossing distances at intersections with painted neckdowns
- Convert curbside parking to short-term loading and pick-up/drop-off space

Implementation begins August 12th
