**Highlights**

1. This year's legislative session is wrapping up on June 10th, and the Assemblymember is focusing on efforts to bring some of his bills to the floor for a vote. The first one is A.81, which would prevent foster youth from going through unnecessary background checks. This bill clarifies that background checks of foster youth turning eighteen are not required as a matter of course. The other one is A.7126, which would extend the current co-op and condominium tax abatements. This bill would continue the abatement program for individuals who live in co-ops and condominiums in New York City. If you or anyone has questions about our legislation please reach out to our office.
2. The Emergency Rent Assistance Program (ERAP) has officially begun taking applications as of June 1st, where folks who are struggling to pay rent due to the pandemic can apply for financial assistance.
