September 2021 Full Board Report to Manhattan Community Board 6

Highlights

1. The Legislature returned to Extraordinary Session at the call of Governor Hochul on September 1

2. Eviction and Foreclosure Moratorium Extension During Extraordinary Session

On September 1 the legislature extended the residential eviction moratorium, and the Tenant Safe Harbor Act, the residential foreclosure moratorium, the eviction and foreclosure moratorium for small businesses.

Those who apply for CERAP are automatically protected while their application is still pending. Tenants whose CERAP application is approved, receive various protections including 12 months of eviction protection. To get started on your claim, please visit: <https://otda.ny.gov/programs/emergency-rental-assistance/>. Additionally, Governor Hochul will be sending increased community liaisons to neighborhoods, who will be able and willing to assist residents with their applications, and my office can provide assistance as well.

3. The legislative package also authorized any state or local public body, including community boards, to hold virtual public meetings until January 15, 2022
