Highlights

1. Congresswoman Maloney, with her colleagues, introduced legislation to make Diwali a federal holiday, reintroduced the Pandemic Risk Insurance Act (PRIA), and passed the PUMP for Nursing Mother's Act
2. The Congresswoman also introduced a bill to combat census disinformation
3. In her role as chair of the Oversight Committee, she held a hearing with top fossil fuel executives and subpoenaed them for key documents
4. The Oversight Committee marked up \$12B to electrify the USPS and Federal Vehicle Fleets, \$60 Million in funding for the National Archives to clear backlogs of veterans' record requests, \$4M in funding to implement President Biden's Justice40 Initiative, and \$50M in funding to the Inspectors General and Government Accountability Office to ensure funds are spent appropriately.
5. The Financial Services Committee also marked up a portion of the Build Back Better Agenda which calls for a \$150 Billion investment in housing affordability in our country. The Congresswoman is optimistic that New York will receive a large share. She has heard that New York City will receive about \$40M of that for public housing.
