Highlights

1. Assemblymember Quart is gearing up for the 2022 legislative session next month, and we have been focusing on particular bills to push for next year. Such bills include promoting pre-trial stability (A.4558B), reforming wrongful convictions (A.98), reforming background checks on foster youths (A.81) and prohibiting the use of reverse search warrants (A.84). If you would like to show support or opposition to any particular issues that could be brought up next session, please reach out to our office.
2. Two important laws are set to expire on January 15th: the eviction moratorium and the extended open-meetings law. At this moment we are not sure of any plans to extend the eviction moratorium, but come the Governor's state of the state and the release of her executive budget we could find out more information. The same applies to the open-meetings law, where our Chief of Staff attended CB6's Budget & Government Affairs meeting last month to discuss this topic. There are existing bills that would permanently establish online options for community meetings and to extend the current law. The Assemblymember supports A.8314 and A.8155, which are the bills the committee discussed in their meeting. Like the eviction moratorium, we will have to wait for next month and the executive budget to be released on what the next steps are.
