Highlights

- 1. Assemblymember Quart, along with Assemblymember's Harvey Epstein and Jessica Gonzalez-Rojas, and State Senators Robrt Jackson and Julia Salzar met with New York City Commissioner of Corrections Louis Molina a few weeks ago to discuss current conditions on Rikers Island and how the Department of Corrections plans on dealing with them. This relationship is ongoing and these legislators plan to meet with Commissioner Molina again to keep up to date on these conditions and the progress the DOC is making to resolve them.
- 2. The NYS Legislative Task Force on Demographic Research and Reappointment released the new maps for Congressional, State Senate and Assembly districts. Our office is actively reviewing these maps, and if constituents have comments they'd like to share with us on them, please reach out to us.
- 3. Recently, the State Assembly passed legislation that would allow all New Yorkers to vote by absentee ballot in the 2022 primary, special, and general elections.
