**February 2022 Full Board Report to Manhattan Community Board 6**

**Highlights**

1. Carlina named Chair of the Committee on Criminal Justice in New York City Council. The committee has oversight authority over the Department of Corrections, Department of Probation, and Board of Corrections. This committee will be essential in ensuring the City addresses the multiple humanitarian crises at Rikers Island while centering the health and safety of all those impacted by the criminal legal system and protecting the rights and safety of all New Yorkers. Carlina will also sit on the Committees on Hospitals, Housing and Buildings, Land use, Standards and Ethics, and the Subcommittee on COVID Recovery and Resiliency.
2. Carlina distributed over 100 COVID-19 at-home test kits at Straus Houses on Monday, January 31 with the Straus Houses Tenant Association. Stay tuned for more test kit giveaways throughout the district, or contact our District Office for more information at 212-677-1077.
3. Carlina delivered KN95 and children’s sized masks to the staff and students at PS 116 in late January to help increase their PPE supplies and respond to the latest surge in COVID-19 cases. Carlina is visiting schools throughout the District to understand their needs and provide support.
4. On January 24, new laws protecting delivery workers and passed by City Council last fall went into effect. This includes a delivery worker hub at the Department of Consumer and Worker Protections to help workers understand their rights, and Carlina’s bill that ensures bathroom access to delivery workers.
5. On February 12, Carlina is joining advocates and impacted New Yorkers to call on Mayor Adams to end the Tax Lien Sale.
