Highlights

- Carlina introduced several new pieces of legislation, including a bill that would guarantee
 free access to medical abortion in New York City. The bill (Intro 507) would require every
 City-run health care site to offer FDA-approved mifepristone and misoprostol, also known
 as Mifeprex, Korlym, and Cytotec, at no cost to the patient. Carlina remains committed to
 ensuring that all can access reproductive healthcare and that New York City remains a
 safe-haven for abortion access.
- 2. Carlina joined Stuyvesant Park Neighborhood Association and NYC Clean Volunteers on May 21st for a cleanup of Stuyvesant Square Park. Carlina has also called for Parks to start holding operations meetings at Stuyvesant Square Park and looks forward to working with community stakeholders in taking care of the park and neighborhood.
- 3. On June 18^{th,} join the National Arts Club and Mexican Cultural Institute at a live mariachi concert on the stoop from 1pm 3pm, followed by dancing inside.
- 4. On Sunday, June 12th, Carlina will be attending the 65th annual Puerto Rican Day Parade. Carlina looks forward to joining the community in celebrating Puerto Rican Heritage.
- 5. Carlina Chaired an Executive Budget Hearing on the Department of Corrections and Board of Corrections on May 23. Read Carlina's op-ed with Darren Mack of Freedom Agenda on the Mayor's proposed Executive Budget HERE. City Council is still negotiating a budget with the Mayor, and it is expected later this month.
