Highlights

1. After collecting feedback from constituents and neighbors, the Assemblymember submitted testimony to the Districting Commission in response to the NYC City Council preliminary redistricting maps. He encouraged the Commission to reconsider its decision to separate Upper East Side neighborhoods that have strong cultural, education, and transportation ties and have historically shared political representation. Specifically, the Assemblymember recommended that the Manhattan neighborhoods of Sutton Place, Roosevelt Island, and the Upper East Side remain represented by a Manhattanite.
2. The Assemblymember recently participated in a forum on the issue of gun violence at the 92NY Bronfman Center for Jewish Life. Along with New Yorkers Against Gun Violence and Street Corner Resources, he discussed solutions and highlighted the gun safety legislation passed by the Legislature earlier this year.
3. In his capacity as Chair of the Administrative Regulations Review Commission, the Assemblymember wrote to the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation to urge the adoption of substantive regulatory changes to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from solid and hazardous waste facilities.
