**[December 2022] Full Board Report to Manhattan Community Board 6**

**Highlights**

1. Manhattan District Attorney Alvin Bragg will announce a new multi-million dollar initiative to reach New Yorkers with deeply entrenched needs and connect them with comprehensive wraparound community support services, including housing assistance and treatment for mental illness and substance use disorders, in order to keep them and their neighbors safe. The District Attorney's Office is seeking to invest in intervention at two distinct points: purely preventative neighborhood-based interventions that are not linked to criminal justice contact; and intervention immediately after criminal court arraignment that operates outside any court-mandated programming. The "Neighborhood Navigators" will work directly in areas with high levels of unhoused individuals with mental health challenges or substance use issues. These navigators are not part of the criminal justice system. For individuals who are justice-involved, the court-based navigators will serve people who are eligible for pre-arraignment diversion, and certain people who have been arraigned on non-bail eligible offenses.
2. DA Bragg joined the Mayor's Office to discuss how law enforcement partnerships stopped a potential attack on the Jewish community. "We do not tolerate illegal guns in this city, we do not tolerate hate and anti-Semitism in this city, and we do not tolerate violence in this city."

Manhattan DA Alvin Bragg and NYC Police Commissioner Keechant Sewell announced the indictment of Cory Davis for manufacturing and possessing 14 ghost guns and possessing hundreds of rounds of ammunition in his Upper East Side apartment. "The allegations make it evident that by manufacturing these weapons, Davis put not only the public, but a child in serious peril," said District Attorney Bragg.
