Highlights

- 1. End-of-Session: The 2023 New York State Legislative Session is scheduled to close this Friday, June 9th. Assemblymember Bores is currently on track to be the most effective first-term member of the Assembly this year, with several bills moving forward in the next 48 hours.
- 2. Judicial Bill Passes the Assembly: Assemblymember Bores has spoken at length regarding the need to increase the speed and efficiency of the judicial system and we are delivering results to that end. The bill, which will increase the number of Supreme, Family, and Civil Court judges in several districts in need across NYC and statewide, has passed the Assembly. This increase will ease the congestion in our judicial system and benefit all New Yorkers.
- 3. Optometry, Labor IP, and Telemarketing Bills Heading to the Governor's Desk: A trio of bills carried through the Assembly by AM Bores have passed both chambers of the legislature, and are set to become law pending a signature by Governor Hochul. The bills will increase the number of optometrists in New York State, protect workers' intellectual property, and significantly increase the fine on telemarketing scammers respectively. Our office is proud these common sense measures, which will immediately impact our constituents and the state writ-large, will soon be enacted.
