## 1) Welcome to CB6's New Board Members

The Manhattan Borough President's Office is thrilled to welcome our new and returning board members to CB6. ## 2) Manhattan Borough President Levine Testifies against rent hikes to the Rent Guidelines Board

On June 13<sup>th</sup>, Manhattan Borough President Levine testified against rent increased proposed by the Rent Guidelines Board. The Borough President firmly believes that now is not the time to raise rents on New Yorkers already struggling to pay their rent. An alarming 39.5% of rent stabilized households spend more than 50% of their household income on gross rent. The housing crisis facing our city only further burdens tenants across the city, with a lack of housing options driving median rent to as high as \$5,000 in Manhattan – well beyond the means of many New Yorkers today.

The Borough President also joined Manhattan Council Members in calling for an in-person hearing to located in Manhattan. Despite the decision to not hold a Manhattan hearing, you can still submit testimony through June 15<sup>th</sup>:
