#### **Highlights**

1. Last month, Senator Kristen Gonzalez rallied with housing advocates outside of Governor Hochul's Manhattan office, calling on the Governor to sign four bills that protect rent-stabilized housing and address illegal and fraudulent rent hikes.
2. The Senator's office will be holding mobile office hours on Tuesday, November 14<sup>th</sup>, at the Stuytown Community Center from 2-5pm. We look forward to providing assistance to constituents on the ground in the district.
3. In legislative news, Senator Gonzalez's bill, S.5915, was signed into law by Governor Hochul. This bill requires the Office for the Prevention of Domestic Violence to distribute informational materials on economic abuse to places like temporary shelters, social service offices, and childcare facilities. These materials will include information on how to spot economic abuse, how to prevent it, how survivors of it can get help, and will clearly identify economic abuse as a form of domestic violence
